Carrara Marble is a classic Italian marble known for its soft white background and subtle grey veining. It is primarily valued for interior architectural applications where visual refinement is prioritized over extreme durability. This material should be specified with a clear understanding of its chemical sensitivity and patina behavior.

Recommended Applications

Suitable for: Interior wall cladding, Interior residential floors (low to medium traffic), Bathroom walls (non-shower zones), Decorative architectural elements (fireplace surrounds, feature walls)
Typical use cases: Residential interiors, Hospitality public areas with controlled maintenance, Low-impact commercial interiors

Surface Finishes

Recommended finishes: Honed – preferred finish for floors and walls, Polished – decorative use only (walls, low-contact areas)
Finish guidance: Honed surfaces reduce visual contrast of etching and daily wear, Polished surfaces highlight veining but increase slip and etch visibility

Slip Rating (Indicative)

Honed finish: R9 – R10, Polished finish: R9
Not suitable for wet floors or pool-related environments.
Slip resistance may vary depending on quarry, finish process, and maintenance regime.

Dimensional Tolerances

Tiles: ±1.0 mm, Slabs: ±2.0 mm
Tolerance values assume calibrated material and controlled production standards.

Recommended Adhesive & Installation

Adhesive:
• White cement-based flexible adhesive
• Classification: C2TE S1 (EN 12004)
Installation notes:
• Full bed coverage required (back-buttering recommended)
• Avoid dark or fast-setting adhesives
• Allow for natural stone movement joints

Maintenance & Aging Behavior

Carrara Marble is acid-sensitive.
Expected behavior over time:
• Etching from acidic substances (wine, lemon, vinegar)
• Gradual surface dulling in high-contact zones
• Development of patina rather than uniform wear
This aging is normal and irreversible and should be accepted as part of the material's character.

Not Recommended For (Critical)

Carrara Marble should not be specified for: Pool decks or pool coping, Shower floors, Exterior applications, High-traffic commercial floors, Kitchen countertops with heavy daily use, Any area requiring low-maintenance or stain resistance

Ignoring these limitations typically results in premature dissatisfaction and surface damage.

Specification Notes (For Project Documents)

Specify honed finish for most applications
Clearly state “interior use only” where applicable
Do not substitute with “Carrara-type” or trade-name variants without verification
Include maintenance expectations in client documentation
